	rooms? Head of School: Capacity of school limits the number of clubs we can run. Lego club needs a new volunteer to run it.	
Afterschool Sport's competitions	Head of School: Miss Wilkin PE Lead. Mr Scott from Planet Soccer has taken on admin duties. Putting a list of what is happening and when. Parent view: Cross country competition Thursday 13 October more children could have gone. Football Tournament. No coach only parents. Could we publicise events earlier so there is time for people to sign up for events. Could we do a google form application rather than paper form? Head of School: Coaches want to do some sessions at lunchtime to practice for matches. Planet Soccer cannot go to afterschool matches. Took too many children to football tournament, too many subs, want to make sure all the children have a good time.
