This Policy has been approved adadopted in January 2025 and will be reviewed in January 2027 At St Cuthbert Mayne Catholic Primary School, we are proud of our smart school uniform. It helps us to identify each other as a community of learners, believers and friends.

As a school community, we do our best to make sure that everyone has the same uniform and that parents and children help to make decisions about the best uniform for our school. In 2024, we reviewed our uniform supplier and made Mapac our main supplier.

Many items of our school uniform, including trousers, shirts and dresses, can be bought from any supplier. Some items have our school logo on them and must be bought from Mapac.

Our Parent Association understands the environmental and financial challenges of purchasing new uniforms for growing children. To support our school community, The Friends run a termly second-hand uniform sale, offering pre-loved items at a nominal contribution to The Friends fund. This initiative not only promotes sustainability but also helps families save on uniform costs. Additionally, parents and carers can use the marketplace on ClassList to buy and sell uniform items directly within the school community.

Families who find it difficult to purchase uniform will always be provided with the items they need – please speak to the Head of School who will be happy to help
